buildings to a high standard with a view to ensuring our community benefits from the very best. Local residents who reside in Quedgeley/Kingsway continue to receive a favoured rate when booking our facilities as a thank you for your loyalty and to reflect the fact that these facilities are on your doorstep.

The 2023/24 budget has been carefully considered as your councillors are keen for business to continue as normal, whilst remaining mindful of the financial pressures faced by our local residents. All our events will continue with the popular Easter Egg Hunt at the Quedgeley Nature Reserve on Easter Monday, our Dog Show event on Sunday 4th June at Kingsway Sports Pavilion, our Fireworks event on Saturday 11th November and our newly established but very popular Christmas event on Sunday 10th December 2023. All of these events are either free or very cheap to attend, our main focus being that we want to provide as much opportunity for our residents to come together and feel like a community. There is also a Coronation Event being held on Sunday 7th May which is being organised by the local charity Help if we can but supported by this council.

Projects: Improvements to Quedgeley Community Centre, a coronation bench and Improvements to Kingsway Community Centre to name a few, as well as maintaining open spaces, playgrounds, allotments and the cemetery.
